Plan your course so as to arrive around the west end of the breakwater; a green buoy about 100' out off the end, and a red buoy on the breakwater's end will help you; there is also a pair of range marks on the shore to guide you in. Turn to starboard around the rock breakwater, you will pass fish houses and a frozen food facility to port, with a large "ICE" sign atop them. Continue around to port, past the Gate 1 Fuel Dock. Continue back toward shore. As you near the shore, you will see the BYC dock parallel to the shore and directly in front of the BYC Clubhouse building (Club rooms are on the lower floor, with the restaurant above). Take any available slip not marked "reserved". Visits limited to three nights stay. First night is free. Additional nights at \$0.50/ foot.

Pump-out located on the breakwater as you make turn into marina at the head of breakwater to the left.

At that time, one of the staff members will be able to assist you with moorage and provide you with an entry gate key and a visitor pass . Fly club burgee while moored at dock. Dress code: Blazers, white trousers. "A" dock available. One day free, \$0.25/ft for additional days. 7 day maximum stay. 30 and 50 amp service, fresh water and fuel dock for registered CRYC Guest. Insurance policy for \$1 million required, with CRYC named as "Additionally insured". We ask that you contact the front office and notify them of the dates that you plan to visit. Please be prepared to present an active member identification card issued by your club. If you are bringing in a boat and are interested in staying on the guest dock, you will need to make arrangements with the office two weeks in advance, at a minimum. Moorage privileges at Bellingham, Washington's Squalicum Harbor. Vacant member slips will be used for reciprocity. 24 hour limit. Upon entering the EAST entrance of Squalicum Harbor in Bellingham Bay, proceed past the Bellwether Hotel and Anthony's Hearthfire Restaurant (on your starboard).
